CONSTITUTION

1. NAME

THE NAME OF THE SOCIETY IS PIONEER BIBLE CAMP.

2. THE PURPOSES OF THE SOCIETY ARE:

- a) To promote the cause of the Christian religion.
- b) To operate camps under Christian supervision.
- c) To work in cooperation with all evangelical churches with a program that complements their ministry.
- d) To receive, hold and disperse gifts, bequests, and other funds.
- e) To own and maintain suitable real estate and buildings for the purpose of the Society to fulfill its ministry.

3. The purpose of the Society shall be carried out without purpose of gain for its members any gains or other accretions to the Society shall be used for promoting its purposes.

4. The operations of the Society are to be mainly carried on in the Township of Smoky Lake in the Province of Alberta.

5. Legal description of Society property is PTN.E-19-61-17-w4

6. All property owned by the Society shall be registered in the name of the Society.

7. Fundamental spiritual principles of the Society are as follows:

A. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament as verbally inspired by God, and inerrant in the original writings and that they are of supreme and final authority in faith and life.

B. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

C. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man.

D. We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death, but also that spiritual death which is separation from God; that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and in the case of those who reach moral responsibility, become sinners in thought, word and deed.

E. We believe that the Lord Jesus died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice and that all that believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood.

F. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into heaven and in His present life there for us as High Priest and Advocate.

G. We believe in the blessed hope, the personal and premillennial and imminent return of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

H. We believe that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God.

I. We believe in a Christian life that is separated from the world as clearly stated in the Scriptures.

J. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.

K. We believe in the spreading of the Gospel as Jesus said, "Go ye into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature." Mark 16:15
